Art exhibition – **TRANSMISSION**

Glass and installation by artist Monica L Edmondson is on show at The Glassery, Stockholm, from November 7th to December 2nd 2009.

Monica L Edmondson is often exploring a feeling, or a mood, such as a winter room of space and light through her glasswork. It can stem purely and simply from a linear movement or absorption /reflection of light. Her brightly coloured surfaces, taking their palette from her Northern Swedish, Sami background, blaze with life.



Winter-white, light and ice

predominate again in Edmondson's glass, video and sound installation entitled "Luodda –Track", based on a verbal narrative tradition. The artist is concerned that today's media flood will drown this ancient art. The stories she heard in her childhood are in danger of being lost.

For her November exhibition at The Glassery, Monica L Edmondson has selected one of these tales. Its representation at the gallery is the installation which features Sami folk music, strange tracks in the snow and an atmosphere of mystery.

At the opening of the exhibition on Saturday 7th November, 11 AM – 4 PM, the artist will be there to make her own presentation.
